

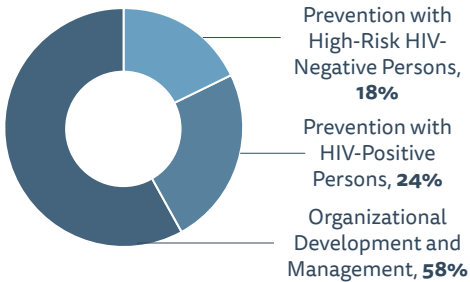


# YEAR TWO IN REVIEW

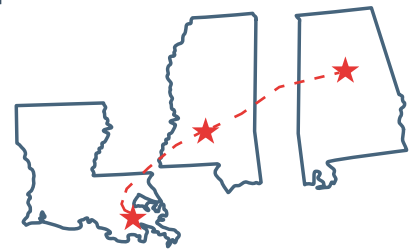
