

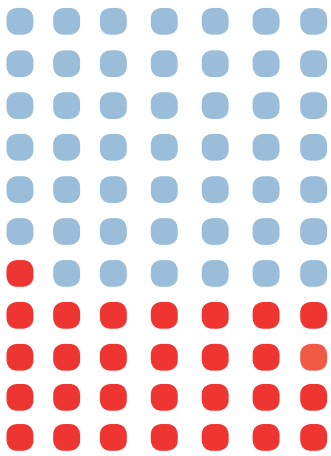


YEAR ONE IN REVIEW

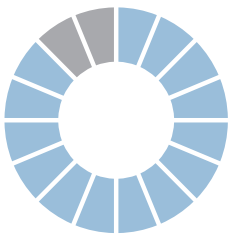


29 addressed **PS15-1502 pre-application** TA needs.
